I was brought in to take on the design of a new product for Upstart. My time there was short but productive. When I joined the organization the team had been working on the project for months, so I had some catching up to do and needed to define the process to make it happen. The goal was to establish a clear product design vision in time to inform our plans for the following quarter. I started by working from the product team's existing strategy as well as interviews and competitive research to establish a clear scope, timeline and expectations for the design work. I took on the design of each phase of the user experience under tight timelines, and worked closely with the product and engineering team to iterate and improve as I went. I assembled each phase into an end-to-end workflow as I went, then refined the design into an interactive prototype and laid the groundwork for a few rounds of usability testing, all in about three months.
